ECD 2017 & 2nd IWC-HTS, September 13 -15, 2017, Karlsruhe, Germany

The **European Cryogenics Days 2017** will be organised in conjunction with the **2nd International Workshop on Cooling of High-Temperature Superconductor Applications** in Karlsruhe, Germany, 13 -15 September 2017. This meeting is preceding the European Conference on Applied Superconductivity (EUCAS) that takes place at CERN, Geneva, September 17-21.

The meeting is organised by the *Karlsruhe Institute of Technology* (KIT), the *Cryogenics Society of Europe* (CSE) and the *European Society on Applied Superconductivity* (ESAS) together with the *HEPTech Network* and *Enterprise Europe Network* (EEN).

On Wednesday September 13, the program will start with the annual general meeting of the CSE (open to all attendees but voting restricted to CSE members only), followed by a one-day program with plenary talks on general topics relevant to cryogenics. On Thursday 14 and Friday 15, the International Workshop on Cooling of HTS Applications (IWC-HTS) will be held with plenary talks and a poster session. The workshop is a follow-up of the first IWC-HTS held in October 2015 in Japan. Students presenting their work in the poster session are eligible to reduced participation fees.

Throughout this 3-day meeting, exhibitors will be showing their products and face-to-face meetings will be organised to which attendees can register.
